### **Data protection policy**

When you use our Internet pages, a variety of personal data is collected. Personal data is data with which you could be personally identified. This data protection statement sets out what data we collect and what we use it for. It also explains how and why this occurs.

This statement applies to the data processing carried out by Globomedica as well as the sites that can be accessed via www.globomedica.ch. Please bear in mind that references may be made to further websites to which different data protection regulations may apply.

This data protection statement is governed by Swiss law. Where applicable, the provisions of the European Union (EU), particularly the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), will be taken into account.

#### 1. Collected data

We adhere to the legal provisions of the applicable data protection laws when collecting and processing personal data. The legal bases are Article 13(1) of the Swiss Data Protection Act (FADP) or, where applicable, Article 6(1), sentence 1(b and f) of the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

#### 1.1 General collection on the website

Every time our webpages are accessed, they collect a range of general data. This general data and information is stored in the server's log files. The following data is collected:

- IP address
- Date and time of request
- Time zone difference to the GMT time zone
- Content of the request
- Access status/http status code
- Respective data volume transmitted
- Website from which the request originates
- Browser (incl. language and version)
- Operating system

The use of this general data does not involve assignment to a specific person. The collection of this data is technically necessary in order to display our webpages to you and ensure their stability and security.

#### 1.2 Making contact

When you contact us via the e-mail addresses provided, we always handle the data you transmit to us in compliance with the applicable data protection regulations. The data you have provided shall be used exclusively to process your request.



### 2. Applications

You can submit your application for a position with us via the e-mail address provided or using the relevant online form. The application documents are handled by us in a strictly confidential manner and solely in regard to filling the position for which you have applied. Without your express consent to the contrary, the (electronic) application dossier will be erased/destroyed once the application process is complete, provided it is not subject to a statutory storage period.

#### 3. Newsletter

You can give your consent to subscribe to our newsletter which we use to let you know about interesting developments. You can use the relevant online form to register. Mandatory details are marked separately; all other details are provided voluntarily. The consent you provide for us to send you the newsletter can be withdrawn at any time, thus unsubscribing you from the newsletter. You can withdraw your consent by clicking on the link provided in every newsletter e-mail or by contacting the person responsible using the details provided in this statement.

Furthermore, we can send you our newsletter as part of a business or contractual relationship with you. You can unsubscribe from the newsletter at any time by clicking on the link provided in every newsletter e-mail or by contacting the person responsible using the details provided in this statement.

### 4. Inventory data for order processing

Personal data is processed for orders insofar as this is necessary for the contractual relationship. This data is used exclusively to process the contract. In this context, the data is also passed on to third parties insofar as this is necessary for the order processing (for example, in order for goods to be delivered, your name and address need to be passed on to the shipping company). Your personal data will not be forwarded to any third party not involved in the execution of the contract, unless you have given your express consent, or unless there is a statutory basis for this. This data will be deleted once the statutory storage periods have ended, unless you have expressly consented to its further use.

### 5. Cookies

Our website uses cookies, which are small text files that are stored on your computer and can be accessed again. Cookies enable you to register for our services and personalise the website for you. To do this, our website is supported by cookies, which collect information about your IP address, the time and duration of your visit, the number of times you have visited, your use of forms, your search preferences, your view mode and your favourites settings on our website. The storage period for cookies can vary.

You can prevent cookies from being placed by our website at any time via the relevant settings on the Internet browser in use, thus permanently preventing the placing of cookies. ### 7. Web tracking

Our webpages use Google Analytics, a web analysis service of Google Inc. ("Google"). Google Analytics uses cookies that facilitate an analysis of the use of our website. The information generated by the cookie about your use of the website is anonymised, transmitted to a Google server in the USA and stored there. Thanks to the anonymisation, this data cannot be assigned to a specific person. Google will use this information to analyse your use of the website, compile reports on user activities and provide services associated with the use of the website and the Internet. Google may also transfer this information to third parties where required to do so by law or if third parties process this data on behalf of Google. The legal basis is Art. 6, para. 1, sentence 1(f) of the EU General Data Protection Regulation and Art. 13(1) of the FADP.

### 8. Google Maps

On our webpages, we use a plugin from the Internet service Google Maps. The operator of Google Maps is Google Inc. We have no knowledge of the exact content of the data transmitted, nor of how it is used by Google. Google may also transfer this information to third parties where required to do so by law or if third parties process this data on behalf of Google. If you deactivate Javascript in your browser, you prevent Google Maps from working. This however means that you cannot use any map displays on our website.
